“Jekyll and Hyde” Presentations Had Something for Everyone

On Thursday, October 30th and Friday, October 31st the *Jekyll and Hyde Together Again* presentation was held in the Golisano Midlevel Gateway. The two day event discussed “the continuing relevance of Robert Louis Stevenson’s *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* to contemporary issues in philosophy, medicine, psychology, sociology, education and literary criticism.” Representatives from the Schools of Pharmacy, Nursing, Education, and Arts and Sciences were on hand to discuss aspects of the novel relevant to their respective

fields. Dr. Dougie Bicket from the C/J department discussed, “The Many Film Adaptations of ‘Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde.’” In addition to the discussions, artwork inspired by the novel, done by students from the School Without Walls, was on display and Lavery Library showcased various Jekyll and Hyde editions and memorabilia. Showings of both the 1931 and 1940 film adaptations closed both days of presentations. The event was sponsored by the Health Humanities Committee.
