

## **Committees of the Faculty Assembly Membership Composition Summary**

### **Faculty Council:**

Eleven members: 3 elected from the faculty in their 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> year of cumulative full-time teaching service at the College; 3 elected from the faculty who have more than 6 years of cumulative full-time teaching service at the College; 3 elected at large from the faculty; the President of the College, or a representative, and one appointee of the President. Three year terms; 1 member from each group shall be elected every year; members may be re-elected.

### **Graduate Program Council:**

The Provost; the Dean of School of Adult and Graduate Education (SAGE); the School Dean, where applicable, the Directors of the graduate programs, the Chair of the Curriculum & Instruction Committee; one representative elected at-large from the Faculty Assembly who shall have taught at least one graduate course in each of the prior four semesters for a term of two years; and at the Council's discretion, from 1 to 3 students.

### **Curriculum and Instruction:**

15 members: Nine elected faculty members: one each from Business, Education, Nursing, four from Arts and Sciences (one from each of the divisions and one at-large), and two tenured, at-large faculty. Additional members: the Provost the Library Director (or designee), the Registrar, the Associate Registrar and two students. Faculty, staggered 3 year terms with the possibility of re-election; students, 1 year with the possibility of reappointment.

### **Rank and Tenure:**

Six members: Provost and five elected faculty; five years on a staggered basis, members may not serve consecutive terms.

### **Enrollment Management:**

Twelve members: the Provost or designee; the Vice President of Enrollment Management and Planning, the Director of Freshmen Admissions, the Director of Transfer and Pharmacy Admissions, and six elected faculty members: one each from Business, Education, Nursing and three from Arts & Sciences (at-large); and two appointed students designated by the Student Government Association. Faculty members, 3 years on a staggered basis with the possibility of re-election; students, 1 year with the possibility of reappointment.

### **Library:**

Eleven members: Eight elected faculty members: one each from Business, Education, Nursing, Pharmacy, four from Arts and Sciences (one from each of the three divisions and one at-large). Additional members: one graduate student; one undergraduate student and the Director of the Library. Faculty, staggered 3 year terms with the possibility of re-election; students, 1 year with the possibility of reappointment.

### **Faculty Welfare:**

Ten elected faculty members: one each from Business, Education, Nursing, Pharmacy, four from Arts and Sciences (one from each division and one at-large), one faculty member in retirement or on the Bridge to Retirement, and one part-time member of the faculty. Additional members: the Provost, the Vice President for Financial Affairs and the Director of Human Resources. Elected faculty members, will serve staggered 3 year terms with the possibility of re-election.

### **Academic Standing:**

Ten or eleven members: Six elected faculty members: one each from Business, Education, Nursing, and three faculty members from Arts and Sciences (one from each of the three divisions). Additional members: the Provost; the Registrar and/or the Associate Registrar; and

two representatives from the Office of Academic Affairs (one from the Center of Academic Excellence and one from Freshman Advising). Staggered 3 year terms with the possibility of re-election.

**Elections Committee:**

4 members elected from among the faculty; three year staggered terms; members may be re-elected.

**Strategic Review:**

15 members: the Provost; the Academic Dean of each School; and nine elected faculty members, one each from Business, Education, Nursing, Pharmacy, and five from Arts & Sciences (one from each of the three Arts & Sciences divisions, two from Arts and Sciences at-large, with no more than one representative per department, and no more than two per division). Qualifications: Any member of the full-time teaching faculty; Staggered 3 year terms.
